RESPOND TO COMMUNITIES WHERE BLACK AND LATINX PEOPLE ILLICITLY POSSESS AND USE FIREARMS WITH THE SAME EMPATHY THAT IS USUALLY RESERVED FOR COMMUNITIES WHERE WHITE PEOPLE ILLICITLY POSSESS AND USE OPIOIDS.
